EASEMENT VISUAL INSPECTIONS WILL BE DONE ANNUALLY BY CONSERVANCY STAFF AND, IF DESIGNATED IN THE EASEMENT DEED, THE CONSERVANCY PERIODICALLY

WILL CONTRACT ON A FEE-BASIS TO PERFORM A FORMAL INSPECTION OF THE PROPERTY.

IF DETERIORATION OF THE PROPERTY IS OBSERVED THE CONSERVANCY WILL THEN FOLLOW CERTAIN DETAILED PROCEDURES SEEKING TO REMEDY THE DETERIORATION. THE CONSERVANCY WILL ENFORCE AND ADMINISTER PRESERVATION EASEMENTS AS THE CONSERVANCY MAY, IN CERTAIN INSTANCES, APPROVE REQUESTS WRITTEN. FROM PROPERTY OWNERS TO AMEND EASEMENTS. THE CONSERVANCY MAY INITIATE AN AMENDMENT ONLY UNDER CERTAIN STANDARDS.

THESE POLICIES ARE REFLECTED IN THE EASEMENT DOCUMENTS.
