The New York Landmarks Conservancy inaugurated the Chairman's Award in 1988 to recognize exceptional individuals, organizations, and businesses that have demonstrated their dedication to protecting New York's architectural legacy.

About Us

The Landmarks Conservancy's singular mission for more than 50 years has been the protection of New York's built environment – from the iconic buildings that define the City's spectacular skyline to the diverse neighborhoods where we live, work, worship, and play.

We are a strong voice for sound preservation policies. We are also the only organization that empowers New Yorkers with financial and technical assistance to restore their historic homes, cultural, religious, and social institutions. Our grants and loans of \$62 million have mobilized more than \$1 billion in some 2,000 renovation projects throughout the City and State, revitalizing communities, creating economic stimulus, and supporting local jobs.

While most of our work is with individual homeowners and other nonprofit organizations, our achievements have included such high profile projects as the Alexander Hamilton U.S. Custom House, Moynihan Train Hall, Fraunces Tavern block, Federal Archive Building, Astor Row, Ellis Island, and the Survivors' Staircase at Ground Zero.

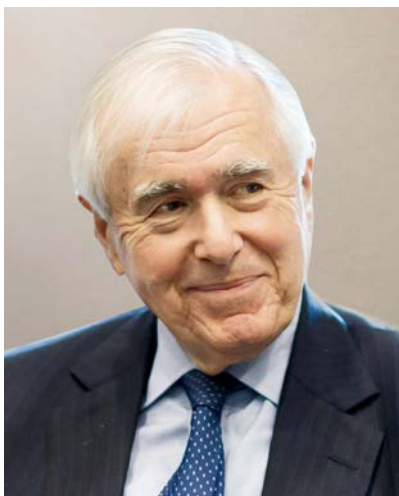

Stanley S. Shuman



Stanley Shuman has been a leader in the investment industry for over 45 years. He has been associated with investment bank Allen & Company since 1961, as Executive Vice President, Managing Director, and now as Senior Advisor. He has also worked extensively in the media industry, serving as a Director of the multinational News Corporation for 23 years.

He was appointed by President Clinton to the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board, was the Chair of the National Law Project on Community

Economic Development. He served on the Financial Control Board for the City of New York for 19 years and on the Board of the Lower Manhattan Development Corporation.

Shuman has led and continues to lead and serve on the boards of many New York institutions including Carnegie Hall; New York Law School; the Wiltwyck School residential treatment center for disadvantaged, emotionally disturbed children; Channel 13/WNET, the Markle Foundation and The Common Good Advisory Council.

He is Trustee Emeritus at Phillips Academy, Andover, the Vail Valley Foundation, and The National Public Radio Foundation. He has also served on the Executive Committee of the Harvard Board of Overseers Committee on University Resources and as Chairman of the Board of Visitors of the Terry Sanford Institute of Public Policy at Duke University.

Shuman is a graduate of Harvard College, Harvard Law School and Harvard Business School. Born in Boston, he remains a lifelong Red Sox fan.

Ian Wardropper



Ian Wardropper was appointed the Anna-Maria and Stephen Kellen director of the Frick Collection in 2011, where he oversaw significant exhibitions, publications, and acquisitions. He led the recently completed renovation and expansion of the beloved institution, creating new spaces for exhibitions, as well as dedicated spaces for educational and conservation initiatives.

The re-opened Frick has garnered wide acclaim. Wardropper also earned praise for "Frick Madison," which housed the collection in the former Whitney Museum during the construction process.

Under his leadership, the Frick Collection expanded its international activities, securing loans and lending works to exhibitions around the world, and hosting numerous international symposiums themed around topics related to works in the collection.

Wardropper is a highly regarded art historian and curator. He began his career at the Art Institute of Chicago and served as Chair of the Metropolitan Museum's Department of European Sculpture and Decorative Arts before joining the Frick.

He was awarded the French Order of Arts and Letters in 2013 for advancing French cultural through exhibitions and partnerships.

Wardropper is a graduate of Brown University and received his doctorate from the New York University's Institute of Fine Arts.

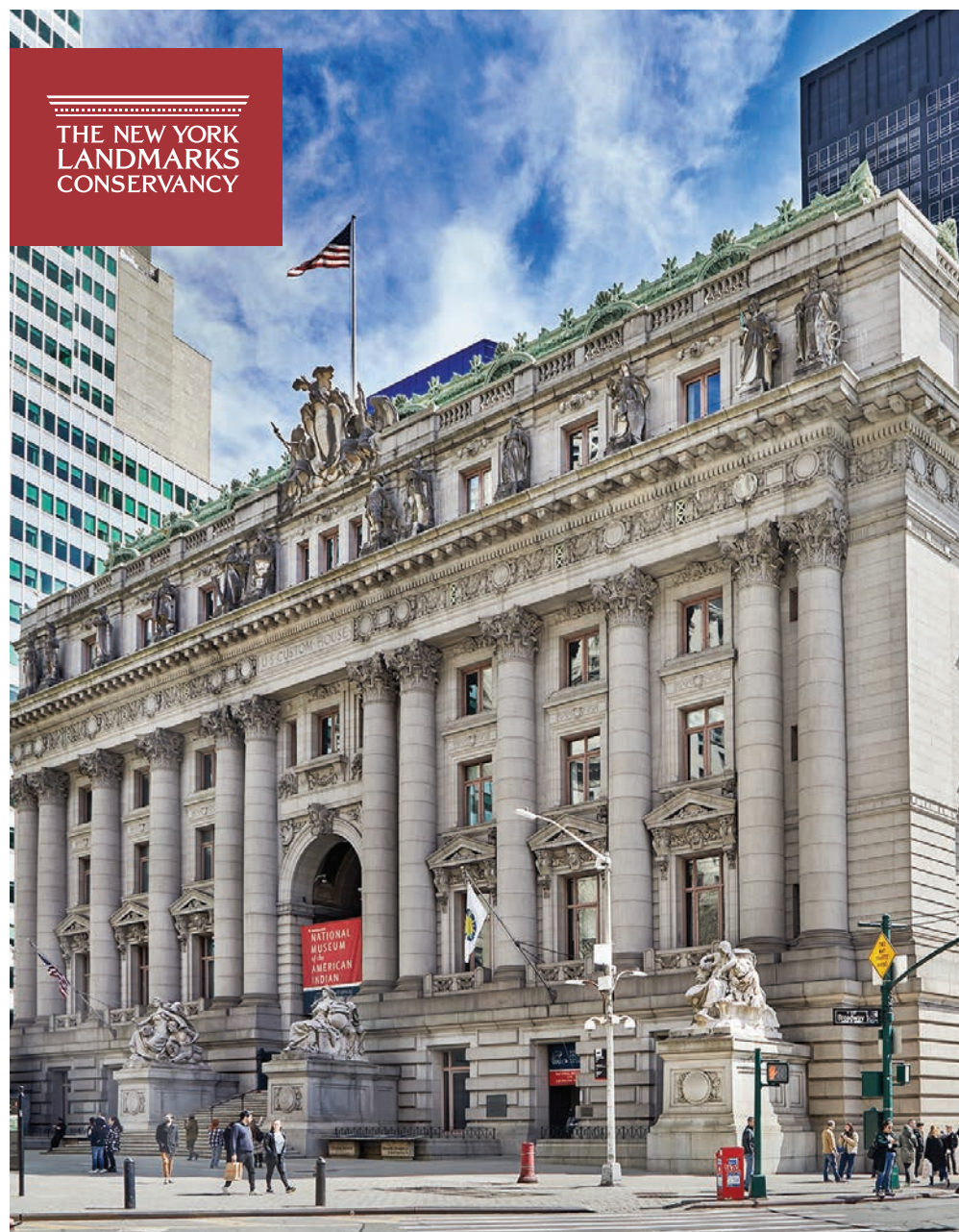
